Dear Friend,

For nearly a decade, Kitty Rescue and Adoption (KRA) has accepted cats regardless of age, regardless of health issues and regardless of their adoptability. It has been a destination for individuals who have experienced financial hardship, encountered special circumstances or who would otherwise euthanize or abandon their cats. KRA has assisted the community by helping to control/reduce the local stray and feral cat population as well as finding loving homes that will give these cats a much deserved "second chance".

For many of these cats, KRA is their last hope.

Take Bobbi for instance. She was brought to Kitty Rescue by a young man who was losing his home and could no longer care for her. Rather than abandon her to the streets to fend for herself, his original plan was to euthanize this sweet, shy, 13 year old cat; he felt he had no other options. Luckily his veterinarian recommended KRA and we gladly took her in. She has subsequently been adopted and will now live the remainder of her life in a second loving home.

Or Janet. She came to us after testing positive for feline AIDS. The largest percentage of shelters in the area, if not the country, will not accept these cats given their special requirements; KRA, however, has a separate room devoted to them. Some of the nicest cats you'll ever meet live together in a cage-free environment and receive the love and acceptance they so richly deserve as well as whatever medical/surgical needs they might require.

And then there was Whiskers. He came to us as an extremely feral and scared cat who had been just barely surviving outdoors. He would have been given up as a lost cause by most shelters but KRA volunteers patiently worked with him to establish trust and love. Over time, he slowly responded. This handsome boy was placed in a home earlier this month and is considered one of our most successful "success" stories.

But to continue this work we need your help more than ever.

We rely solely on donations and adoption fees to sustain our effort which is why your support is critically important. 100% of ALL funds are spent on the care of the cats.
